Public Comments regarding Agenda items: None.

Review/Discussion/Action – Minutes of the April 19, 2023: Mr. Rynders accepted motion to approve minutes as presented, seconded by Ms. Schalinski. Motion carried.

Review/Discussion/Action – Introduction of the new Pepin County Legal Advocate for The Bridge to Hope ~ Ms. Dardine Ms. Dardine is changing positions at The Bridge to Hope after serving Pepin County for six years as the legal advocate. She introduced the new legal advocate Josie Koenigs whom stepped in approximately 9 months ago and will be in Pepin County every Wednesday and hopes to expand hours in the summer.

Review/Discussion/Action – CJCC By-Laws, Suggested Changes and Names of Candidates for Membership Vacancies ~ CJCC Committee Members Judge Clark requested this action item be placed on the July 18, 2023, CJCC Agenda thereby allowing the members to review the Dunn, Eau Claire, and Pierce County By-Laws and either send your ideas to Ms. Berning or utilize Google Docs that Ms. Wood will be creating.

Review/Discussion/Action – Outcome of letter to ask Legislators to support expungement of unnecessary criminal records to provide pathways to employment ~ Mr. Brooks: Mr. Brooks has nothing to report as has had no response from the three elected officials he sent the letter to.

Review/Discussion/Action – Opioid Abatement Effort by Law Enforcement Agencies Grant ~ Any interest in applying, due May 22, 2023, ~ Ms. Berning: Ms. Berning spoke with Mr. Osmond and decided there was not enough time to submit said grant application. Ms. Stewart

asked the Buffalo County Opioid Committee to keep her up to date on a plan for the Opioid Funding the county is receiving.

Review/Discussion/Action – WATCP (Wisconsin Association of Treatment Court Professional) 2023 Annual Conference Updates ~ Ms. Berning and Ms. Bautch: Ms. Berning stated it was a four day conference and learned the TAD Grant Staff are working to remove the violent language in the TAD Statute 165.95, the 25% in-kind match, discussed the new requirements to provide receipts and reports for deposit and expenses and the time that takes away from participant contact. A lot of conversation about focusing on positive behaviors and praising versus shaming participants.

Review/Discussion/Action – Pre-Charge CJS Diversion Video Production Updates ~ Ms. Berning: Video production is on track as outlined in the contract. Everyone has been filmed now waiting for Mitch Stamm to obtain more b-roll. Will finish this up on Wednesday, May 24, 2023.

Review/Discussion/Action – Identify top 3 goals the members would like Buffalo/Pepin CJCC Committee to work on ~ CJCC Committee: Ms. Berning encourages all members to email her items they would like to see this committee work on. One goal is updating/revising the By-Laws. Ms. Campbell Wood stated she would initiate a survey to collect information.

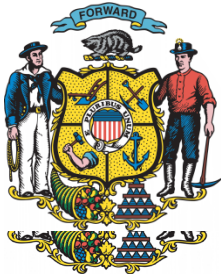

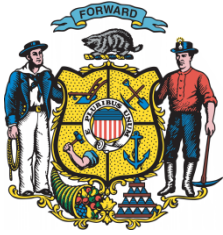

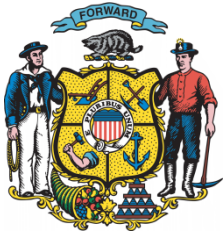
