Public Comments regarding Agenda items: None.

Review/Discussion/Action – Minutes of the July 19, 2022: Mr. Wicktor accepted motion to approve minutes as presented, seconded by Ms. Barclay. Motion carried.

BPLA Updates: Ms. Hartung gave an update on the Buffalo Pepin Literary Alliance as follows:

- BPLA is a non-profit organization that provides free adult education to residents in Buffalo and Pepin County and individuals who are incarcerated. They provide GED/HSED, independent studies and general education.
- There was a technological gap with tutors and learners during COVID and they began the Tech Lending Program and have lent out 10 laptops and 3 hotspots for individuals in rural areas or those without wi-fi.
- In the Buffalo County Jail, they began the Creative Writing Program and had their first session on August 16, 2022 with the focus on poetry. They are 6-month sessions, and each are different. These are used to help for tools to communicate with families and help with skills for employment.
- BPLA currently has 8 learners and tutors. Now that COVID restrictions have lifted, they are partnered back with family farms.
- BPLA used to be county funded but have been grant writing for 2-years and are doing well financially.

CJCC Approve CJS to Apply for the 2023 Proposed TAD Grant Funds: Ms. Bautch presented that CJS would need CJCC approval to apply for the pre-application for the extra 2023

grant money from TAD to use to implement the pre-charge diversion program. Ms. Campbell Wood accepted motion to approve, seconded by Mr. Wicktor. Motion carried.

CJCC 2022 Membership List: Ms. Hansen appointment Ms. Tessa King as the Pepin County Board member and will be added to the membership list.

Updated on Attached Reports:

- **CJCC Financial Update:** Ms. Rieck sent out report (see below). There is no change.
- **Community Work Service (CWS) Report:** Ms. Rieck sent out report (see below). Not much difference and has been slow. Gained 2 new individuals last month.
- **Inmate Status Report:** (see reports below).
 - Buffalo County: Mr. Olson reports things are going well. There has been and uptick in sentenced inmates due to being back to pre-COVID standards and are averaging 11-14 inmates and mainly for drug charges or probation holds. They implemented the new BPLA program (Creative Writing Program) and went well.
 - Pepin County: Mr. McMahon was not present during the meeting. No report submitted.
- **Moving Forward (Jail Reentry) Program Report:** Ms. Campbell Wood presented there are 3 classes being held in the Buffalo and Pepin County Jails and 2 are for both male and females. They introduced the Music Therapy Program that includes art this month. They are waiting on the September calendar in order to distribute for inmates to sign up. Ms. Hartung stated there is a tutor through BPLA who would partner with Moving Forward if needed to help with anything.
- **Veteran's Special Project:** Ms. Campbell Wood stated they are having a 2-part training in Jackson County, a run through with Dunn County Law Enforcement and a 2 or 3-part lunch-in learn with social workers. They are wrapping up at the end of the year and will have a recorded version.
- **CJS Data:** Ms. Bautch sent out report (see below).

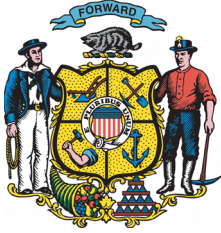
