Meeting called to order at 12:01 p.m.

Public Comments regarding Agenda items: None.

Review/Discussion/Action – Minutes of the March 15, 2022: Mr. Rynders accepted motion to approve minutes as presented, seconded by Mr. Roesler. Motion carried.

CJCC Financial Report: The CJCC financial report was presented with a balance of \$39,350.80 (see below). The invoice was paid to Ms. Campbell Wood for the Jail Reentry Program. There is not much change. Mr. Osmond asked the question regarding the ability to be able to spend this money. Judge Clark responded stating that CJCC is able to spend the money but what it can be spent on will have to be an agenda item for the May 17, 2022 meeting. Mr. Brooks accepted motion to approve the financial report as presented, seconded by Ms. Lieffring. Motion carried.

Community Work Service (CWS) Report: Ms. Rieck sent out report (see below). Mr. Brooks accepted motion to approve the community work service report as presented, seconded by Ms. Lieffring. Motion carried.

Inmate Status Report: (see reports below).

Buffalo County: Mr. Olson reports there are currently ten inmates in the Buffalo County jail and four are on electronic monitoring. He stated the teleconference classes through Ms. Campbell Wood have been successful. They are looking into providing literacy programs. On April 1, 2022, the Huber program opened back up.

Pepin County: Mr. McMahon stated there are seven in custody. They are continuing with the teleconference classes through Ms. Campbell Wood. There have been six bookings this month and forty-one bookings since beginning of the year (2022).

Mayo Hometown Health Grant Application: Mr. Rynders informed the committee, Buffalo County DHHS submitted the grant before the April 15, 2022 deadline for \$25,000 grant money from Mayo Clinic Health systems. The grant supports purchasing mental health and substance abuse counselling and other support services in the Buffalo County Jail. Mr. Rynders has worked with Ms. Campbell Wood to purchase video conference equipment.

Moving Forward (Jail Reentry) Program Report: Ms. Campbell Wood was not able to be present at the meeting. Mr. Rynders provided the updated report. He informed the teleconference classes are going in both Buffalo and Pepin County and both men and women are participating. The Literacy Link Reading Memories has resumed in Pepin County and are hoping it will resume in Buffalo County soon. They purchased two sets of video conferencing equipment for the Mayo Hometown Grant.

CJS Coordinator Report: Ms. Berning was not able to be present at the meeting. Ms. Bautch presented the final March 2022 financial statement (see below). The 1st quarter reports were submitted to TAD.

Ms. Bautch reviewed CJS data report (see below). A new line was added to the data chart to reflect new participants for each quarter. From January 1, 2022 till March 31, 2022, CJS has gained eight new participants and have been very busy with new referrals.
